CHICKENPOX

We have students who have contracted chickenpox. Chickenpox is a very contagious virus. It is spread through the air by infected people when they sneeze or cough, and by touching the chickenpox blisters and then touching objects or other people. Chickenpox is contagious from five days before the blisters appear. It stays contagious until all blisters have crusted over and no new ones are appearing. During this time we ask you to keep your child home from school.
