Our schoolwide Spell-a-thon starts today and ends with a test on Friday 15th September. Please check your child's bag/bookbag for their individual Spell-a-thon booklet sent home today.

This year we are asking each child to find five, \$5.00 sponsors from family and friends. To earn their \$5.00 sponsorship they must get 80% of their words correct in the test. A note to confirm their score will be sent home after marking. Only then can they collect money. If you are able to find more than five sponsors, your child can ask their teacher for another sponsorship form. Although this is a fundraiser, it is also a wonderful opportunity to build spelling knowledge which makes writing so much easier.

These words will be studied in each classroom over the next 3 weeks and we hope you will support your child by helping them to learn the words at home too.
