TE RA - Reward System

At Newton Central School, staff observe positive behaviour in any setting - praise the child and reward a TE RA certificate. The child takes the certificate to the Golden Box in the office. The Golden Box is taken to Assembly each fortnight and 5 certificates are selected at random. The reason for the certificate is read out to the school. Recipients go to the front of Assembly for applause, then to lunch in the Principal's office straight after assembly. All certificates are collected, counted for data purposes, sorted into classrooms and returned to students. The data is on what value certificates have been given, how many per class and by which staff member and the children receiving multiples.

Certificates cover the 4 values -

Truth / Pono - for integrity, honesty and true actions

Excellence / Kairangi - demonstrating excellent behaviour or attitude in work or play

Respect / Whakamana - for behaviour showing respect for peers, adults, equipment or kaupapa

Aroha - for helping to create the kind, supportive, safe, inclusive environment we value
