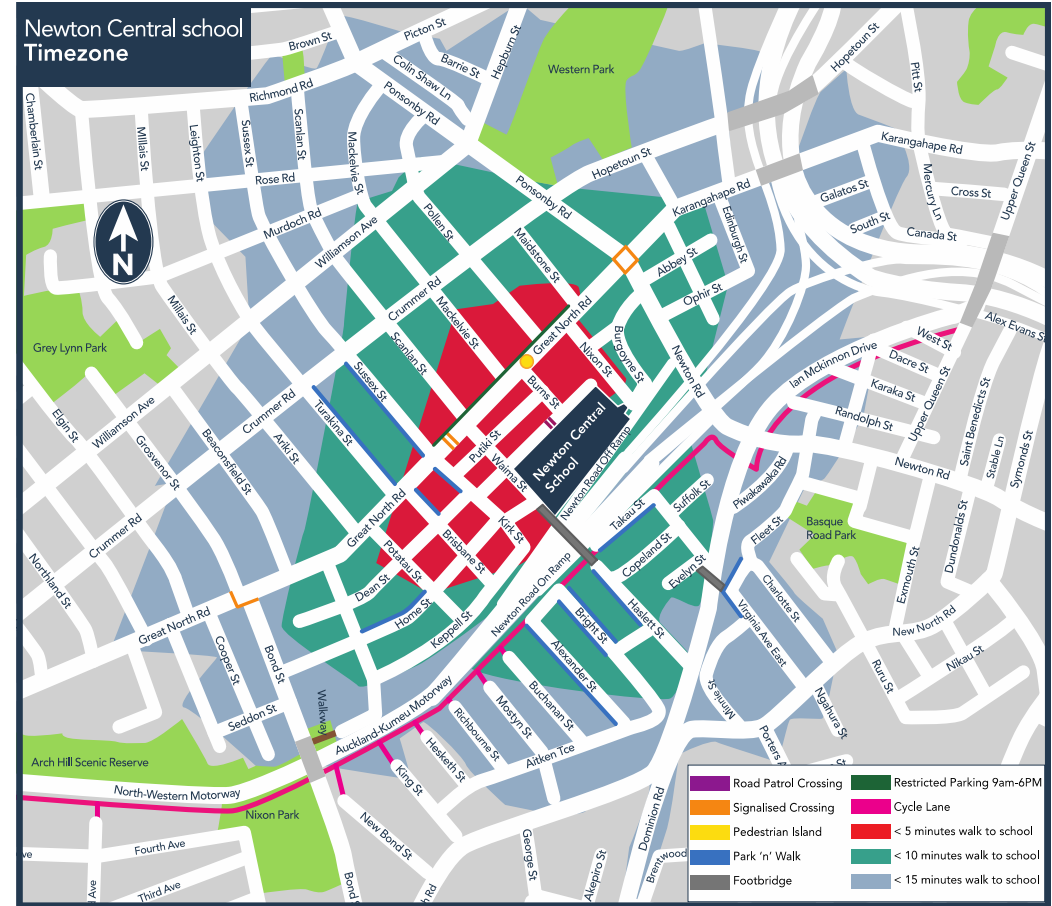
TRAVELWISE - Did you know that.....
